

Lice Aunties After Care Combing Schedule

Each step of our 3-step Treatment (Heat, Combing, Oil Application) has close to a 99% success rate so the combined 3-steps have collective success rate of close to 100%. Having said that it is crucial to follow our post-care treatment schedule.

Oil

Your Lice Auntie will advise you as to the best time to rinse out the oil on the head.

For rinsing, be sure to use a dish liquid soap such as Dawn. You may want to rinse and lather twice to cut all the grease of the oil.

Combing

- Wet hair thoroughly and massage conditioner into hair. Comb through with the Terminator nit comb, wiping on a paper towel after every few swipes. If you are getting nothing after each swipe, move on to the next section.
- First comb completely around the head, the way hair naturally falls. Then comb over to the left and comb starting at the forehead all the way down the head to the nape of the neck. Then do the same to the right.
- Lastly, lean the head slightly forward and comb from the nape to the forehead.
- Make sure you're combing the scalp, not just the hair shaft.

Comb the first and second days after you've been treated.

Take two days off and then comb again for two days. Then, you're done!

Remember, moving forward, the best offense with lice is a strong defense.

Wear hair up, back or in a braid

Use a Lice Repellent daily when your child is with other children regularly

Comb out with a nit comb occasionally to ward off future infestations.

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
